## Four-Down Territory

Spread some 'BASIL' on it: LB Basil Jackson made 11 tackles in his return after missing two games because of a concussion. He has 67 total tackles, ranking second nationally with 13.4 per game.
Woerner the warrior: Zed Woerner is either being sacked or putting up big numbers. Last week, he became the first Tareton QB with 60 career TD passes, and topped 300 passing yards
for the ninth time. in his career. However, he was also sacked five times, pushing his total to 23 sacks this season and 61 since the start of 2016, when he was sacked a career-high nine times by Texas A\&M-Kingsville.
Running woes: Xavier Turner rushed for 216 yards and five TDs in wins over West Texas A\&M and UT-Permian Basin, but had 29 yards and no scores in losses to Western New Mexico and Eastern New Mexico. The team totals
in those four games were 356 yards in the wins
and just 49 rushing yards on 48 carries in the two losses.
Not so one sided lately: A\&M-Kingsville won 10 of its first 11 meetings with Tarleton between 1970 and 1998, and was 16-2 against the Texans after 2005. It's been pretty even since then, with Tarleton winning 8 of 14 including splitting the last 10, 5-5. In the Division II playoffs, the Javs beat the Texans 34-10 in 2003 and Tarleton won 57-56 in a double overtime thriller in 2009.
